The **Non-Profit Academy** will give you a good basic foundation for starting or owning a non-profit even if you have a business background.

Attendees may take seminars separately, if they are not able to complete the series. The Non-Profit series of seminars must be taken at JCC, and do not include any seminars taken before the current semester or at another College. Participants must contact the JCC Small Business Center prior to taking the series, and pre-register for each seminar separately in advance.
