

## **Information About the Health Occupations Test (TEAS)**

- The TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is a health admissions test administered to students applying to the following programs: Medical and Cardiovascular Sonography, Radiography, Nursing, and Nuclear Medicine.
- Everyone applying to one of the above listed programs is required to take the TEAS. Students that are reapplying from previous years will also be required to take the TEAS assessment.
- The cost of the TEAS assessment is \$35 and can be paid on the day of the test at the Cashier's Office.
- Students are scheduled for TEAS after the Allied Health program specific application has been submitted and all program admissions requirements have been met.
- TEAS contains the following sections: Reading, Mathematics, Science, and English. ALL sections of the test are required. The test take 3 hours to complete and can be taken only ONCE per academic year.

- A study guide is available in the JCC bookstore and online at the ATI website.
- A practice test (optional) is available for purchase on ATI's website. Additional study materials may also be found online.
- The Adjusted Individual Total Score (Overall Score) on the test will be added to the applicant's points on the program specific Point Ranking Sheet. For example, if a student scores 70 as the overall score on the test, 70 points are added to their overall points.
- The Academic Skills Center will provide a Test Prep Program for TEAS that helps students prepare for the test. Call 209-2117 for more information.
