## *Program Description*

- Student's tuition is paid for by Johnston County Mental Health.
- Students attend 5\* days a week, 6 hours per day.
- Students will participate in classroom, laboratory, and work experience activities.
- Students will earn a wage for hours of work experience.
- Students who complete the three semester program will receive a certificate from the college.



The Greenhouse and Grounds Maintenance Program at Johnston Community College provides individuals from special populations with experience in general horticultural principles and applications. This training program provides a setting that is conducive to students' vocational and personal growth.

The primary goal of the program is to assist students in securing employment and integration into the community. This is accomplished by providing a therapeutically sound environment that promotes the improvement of work and social skills.
